



## **Emergency Message for U.S. Citizens: Conakry (Guinea), Potential Restless Crowds During Soccer Match** Riots/Civil Unrest

The Guinean national soccer team is playing the Malian national team tonight at 19:00 hrs. local time in Mali. Frustration over lack of consistent electric power to view the game could result in potentially restless crowds in the streets. The embassy urges all U.S. citizens to remain close to home this evening, Tuesday, January 24, 2012.
