



Emergency Message for U.S. Citizens: Bucharest (Romania), Terrorist Activity Worldwide

The U.S. Embassy in Romania alerts U.S. citizens traveling and residing in Romania that due to recent terrorist activity worldwide, we again urge U.S. citizens and staff at U.S. missions to exercise caution and vary their routes and times when traveling to and from work and pay close attention to their personal security. U.S. citizens should consider avoiding demonstrations, crowds, and other large public gatherings. You can stay in touch and get Embassy updates by checking the Embassy website.

These numbers are available from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Eastern Time, Monday through Friday (except U.S. federal holidays).

U.S. citizens are encouraged to enroll in the Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP). U.S. citizens without internet access may enroll directly at the nearest U.S. Embassy or U.S. Consulate. By enrolling, U.S. citizens make it easier for the embassy/consulates to contact them in case of emergency.
