



## **Emergency Message for U.S. Citizens: Yerevan (Armenia), Maintain Vigilance in Yerevan Bars and Nightclubs**

Embassy Yerevan informs all U.S. citizens of recent incidents of vandalism in a few bars and nightclubs in Yerevan. We encourage all U.S. citizens to be cautious and maintain good situational awareness during visits to such establishments. We also recommend that anyone experiencing unwanted attention leave the scene immediately and report any incidents of violence or harassment to the police and to the Embassy.

Enrolling gives U.S. Citizens access to updated information on travel and security within Armenia and makes it easier for the Embassy to contact citizens in case of emergency.
