



## Security Message for U.S. Citizens: Jakarta (Indonesia)

Many of you by now will have seen and heard reports of the attacks earlier this week on the U.S. diplomatic compounds in Cairo, Egypt and Benghazi, Libya and the tragic deaths of four American personnel. These events are a reminder to all of us that the security situation in any location can change rapidly and in unexpected ways. As a result, we strongly encourage you to follow good personal security practices, maintain a heightened situational awareness, and remain vigilant of your surroundings at all times. We advise, as always, that people should avoid large crowds and other gatherings that might turn violent. We will continue to monitor the situation and provide updates if needed.

U.S. citizens living and traveling in Indonesia are urged to enroll in the Smart Traveler Enrollment Program and update their contact information with the U.S. Embassy Jakarta, U.S. Consulate General Surabaya, U.S. Consulate Medan or U.S. Consular Agency Bali. Enrolling facilitates the U.S. Mission's contact with U.S. citizens in emergencies, and may be done online and in advance of travel.
