



## Emergency Message for U.S. Citizens: Tunis (Tunisia), Update on Consular Services

The Consular Section of the U.S. Embassy in Tunis remains temporarily closed to the public for routine American Citizen Services (ACS). All ACS appointments through September 28, 2012 have been cancelled. U.S. citizens requiring emergency passports or needing other emergency assistance should call the Embassy at 216-20-337-541.

All U.S. citizens in Tunisia are encouraged to enroll in the Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP). By enrolling, U.S. citizens make it easier for the Embassy to contact them in case of emergency.
