In light of the ongoing situation at the joint venture facility In Amenas, Algeria, OSAC would like to highlight the following Emergency Messages and Travel Warnings that may provide substantive security information and guidance to constituents operating in the Sahel and North Africa regions, including Morocco, Libya, Tunisia, Niger, Mauritania, and Mali. OSAC reminds all U.S. private sector organizations that they should review their personal security plans, remain aware of their surroundings, including local events, and monitor local news stations for updates. Constituents should also maintain a high level of vigilance and take appropriate steps to enhance personal security.
