



Security Message for U.S. Citizens: Minsk (Belarus), Threat of Violence

The U.S. Embassy informs U.S. citizens of a threat that violence may occur at or near the Minsk Concert Hall in Minsk, Belarus. U.S. citizens should avoid this location, and encourage all persons to exercise caution in any public venue, until February 10, 2016.
