



## Security Message for U.S. Citizens: Manama (Bahrain), February 14 Anniversary

The U.S. Embassy is advising its employees to exercise additional vigilance from tonight throughout this weekend in anticipation of protests associated with the February 14<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Bahraini uprising.

Employees are being instructed to remain clear of all restricted areas (available at <https://goo.gl/Sgn9GE>) and to remain clear of demonstrations and large gatherings of people. If traveling by car, you should know and plan your route well and formulate an alternative routing in the event that you are detoured.
