



Security Message for U.S. Citizens: Monrovia (Liberia), Capitol Demonstration

American citizens in Liberia are advised that a demonstration is taking place at the Capitol building (located near the Temple of Justice) in Monrovia to protest the recent closing of several radio stations, and may last for several hours. Even demonstrations intended to be peaceful can turn confrontational and escalate into violence. You should avoid areas of demonstrations, and exercise caution if in the vicinity of any large gatherings, protests, or demonstrations.
