



Security Message for U.S. Citizens: Bucharest (Romania), Demonstrations on March 6, 2016

The Military Employees Union will hold a demonstration this Sunday, March 6, 2016 from 8:30 AM to 6:00 PM. Up to 25,000 persons are expected and many buses will be parked on the roads near the protest area. While expected to remain peaceful, demonstrators will likely cause road closures and traffic disruptions in nearby areas.

Traffic on Piaa Victoriei will be restricted to 2 lanes in front of the Government, between Aviatorilor Blvd., Calea Victoriei and Lascr Catargiu Blvd. On Paris Street, traffic will be directed one way towards Aviatorilor Blvd. Although the protest is expected remain calm, it is recommended to avoid demonstration areas, stay aware of your surroundings, and readily comply with any orders or requests made by law enforcement.
