



Security Message for U.S. Citizens: Sofia (Bulgaria), Avoid Vicinity of Hotel Pliska

The U.S. Embassy has received information of a possible threat against an unspecified bus line or bus lines in the vicinity of Hotel Pliska (Boulevard "Tsarigradsko shose" 87), in the eastern Sofia neighborhood of Istok. U.S. citizens are advised to avoid the area and to find alternate means of transportation.
