The U.S. Embassy in Suva, Fiji, informs U.S. citizens residing in or visiting our consular district – Fiji, Kiribati, Nauru, Tuvalu, Tonga, French Polynesia, New Caledonia, and Wallis & Futuna -- of a Tsunami Threat Forecast. A magnitude 7.0 earthquake has occurred in the area of Vanuatu at 7:33 AM Fiji local time this morning. The Pacific Tsunami Warning Centre in Hawaii has issued a threat message for the region, including Fiji. The estimated time of arrival of a tsunami wave in Fiji, should one be generated, is 10:09 AM Fiji local time this morning. Tsunami waves reaching less than one meter above the tide level are possible along some coasts of Fiji, Tuvalu, Kiribati, and New Caledonia. Persons located in threatened coastal areas should stay alert for information and follow instructions from national and local authorities.
