



## Security Message for U.S. Citizens: Johannesburg (South Africa), Demonstration in Sandton on July 1

The U.S. Diplomatic Mission to South Africa informs U.S. citizens that a demonstration is expected to take place at the corner of West Street and Fredman Drive in Sandton from 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Friday, July 1. Several groups will be demonstrating with the stated purpose of protesting against Israel. The police anticipate there will be approximately 400 people. Major traffic disruptions are expected in Sandton.

Even demonstrations intended to be peaceful can turn confrontational and escalate into violence. You should avoid areas of demonstrations and exercise caution if in the vicinity of large gatherings, protests, or demonstrations.
