



Security Message for U.S. Citizens: Almaty (Kazakhstan),

Terrorism

The U.S. Consulate General in Almaty, Kazakhstan has been informed of an armed attack against the Almaty District police station. Two police officers were reported killed and there are unconfirmed reports of a second and third attack in the city. Local law enforcement have blocked off the following streets: Masanchi, Zhambyl, Sharipova, and Kabanbai Batyr. The Anti-Terrorism Center of the Republic of Kazakhstan reports the imposition of the critical ('red') level of terrorist alert in the city of Almaty.

The U.S. Consulate General in Almaty advises all U.S. citizens to avoid this area until further notice and to also remain indoors.
