



Security Message for U.S. Citizens: Belmopan (Belize), Tropical Storm Earl

The Government of Belize has issued a tropical storm warning and a hurricane watch for Belize.

A tropical storm warning means that tropical storm conditions are expected somewhere within the warning area within 36 hours.

A hurricane watch means that hurricane conditions are possible within the watch area. A watch is typically issued before the anticipated first occurrence of tropical-storm-force winds and conditions, such as heavy rains, that make outside preparations difficult or dangerous. Be sure to locate a shelter, monitor media reports, and follow all official instructions. Carry your travel documents at all times (e.g., U.S. passport, birth certificate, picture ID's, etc.) or secure them in a safe, waterproof location. You should also contact friends and family in the United States with updates on your whereabouts.
