



Security Message for U.S. Citizens: Bucharest (Romania), Transporters Protest in Bucharest

On Thursday, September 15, Romanian truck drivers plan a large demonstration in Bucharest to protest high insurance prices. Thousands of drivers plan to park up to 5,000 trucks along a major route that many US Embassy employees utilize to commute to/from the Embassy on a daily basis. Due to the protest and large numbers of trucks, traffic is expected to be much worse than normal. Please plan your routes accordingly, avoid the protest areas if possible, and allow extra time when calculating your commute times or going to meetings outside the Embassy on Thursday.

Traffic will be restricted from 5AM to 5PM on the following roads:

- On Kiseleff street, from Piata preseii to Piata Victoriei, central lanes. Lateral lanes will be free for traffic.

- In Piata Victoriei. Traffic will be allowed on 2 lanes in Piata Victoriei, in front of the Government, between Aviatorilor Blvd and calea Victoriei, also Lascar Catargiu Blvd.

The protest rally itself will take place between 09.00-15.00 hrs.
