



## Security Message for U.S. Citizens: N'djamena (Chad) Demonstrations and Ghost Town

The U.S. Embassy in N'Djamena informs U.S. citizens of potential demonstrations Thursday, November 17. Demonstrations are being organized by the opposition party, the New Opposition Front for Alternation and Change (FONAC). The FONAC has also called for a national "Ghost Town" on Tuesday, November 22 from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Even demonstrations intended to be peaceful can turn confrontational and escalate into violence. Please be aware and plan your travel/activities accordingly.

The U.S. Embassy advises U.S. citizens to review and follow the guidance in the Travel Warning for Chad, and remain alert for potentially dangerous situations. Even demonstrations intended to be peaceful can turn confrontational and escalate into violence. You should avoid areas of demonstrations, and exercise caution if in the vicinity of any large gatherings, protests, or demonstrations.
